## Guideline Criteria

The grade of Fellow is an invitational grade of membership available upon upgrade from the grade of Member.

To be eligible for transfer to the grade of Fellow, an applicant shall:

- a.** be nominated (and seconded) by an TPA Fellow or Life Member; and
- b.** have had ten (10) years in active practice in a transport field; and
- c.** have had five (5) years in responsible charge of transport work and/or teams; or, in lieu of b),
- d.** have had a combined ten (10) years in responsible charge of important scientific, educational or managerial activities related to the transport field of a calibre equivalent to that required in b); and
- e.** have held the grade of Member of the AITPM for at least five (5) years, subject to exception at the discretion of a majority vote of the Board of Directors; and
- f.** have served on a Branch Committee for at least one (1) term; or, in lieu of f,
- g.** have made an equivalent contribution to the betterment of the TPA, as recognised by the Board; and
- h.** be prepared to be interviewed to establish suitability.
